BUILDING A LEGACY OF WORSHIP- JOSHUA 5:1-12

WORSHIP DEFINED: Worship is our response in faith to the Almighty God.

Guardrails to Worship- John 4:23-24

We must worship God in SPIRIT and in TRUTH!

1) WE WORSHIP A GOD WE KNOW (Joshua 5:10)

The Israelites celebrated Passover. The Passover was a celebration that God had instituted (Exodus 12:14). During the Passover, they remembered how God had revealed Himself to them, leading to their Exodus from Egypt.

They learned to know God and responded in worship by celebrating the Passover.

We are called to do the same. Psalm 29:2 calls for us to ascribe to the Lord the glory of His name. As God reveals Himself in our lives, we respond in worship, identifying the nature of God that has made Himself known.

2) WE WORSHIP THE SOVEREIGN GOD (Joshua 5:9)

God said that He had removed the reproach of slavery from the people of Israel. During their hardest time, God showed Himself to be the almighty God. They recognized His sovereignty and surrendered themselves and their nation to Him.

Job 1:20-21 is an example of surrender to the Sovereign God in the face of hard circumstances.

3) WE WORSHIP GOD THROUGH OBEDIENCE (Joshua 5:2-3)

At this stage of their journey, circumcision left their nation vulnerable to attack. However, they worshiped through absolute trust and obedience.

God calls us to the same worship of obedience. Read Romans 12:1-2.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

- Head- How has God used my circumstances to reveal His nature?
- Heart- As I consider how God has revealed Himself, does this lead to surrender in other areas of my life? Can I trust Him in those areas?
- Hands- Seeing God at work in our lives is awesome reality. Prayerfully respond to God in what worship He may lead.
