BUILDING A LEGACY OF FAITHFUL OBEDIENCE– JOSHUA 3:7-17

FORGOTTEN VIRTUES OF REMEMBRANCE:

1) STOP

God instructed the Israelites to stop after crossing the Jordan River. The act of stopping caused them to recognize God had done something great. Stopping is the first virtue of remembering. We will not remember what God has done when we do not stop to recognize His work.

“We must stop and prepare ourselves to remember, or we will forget what God has done.”

2) BUILD

God directed one person from each of the tribes of Israel to bring a stone from the Jordan river into their camp. Once at camp, the stones were built into a memorial to remind future generations of what God had done for their people at the Jordan river.

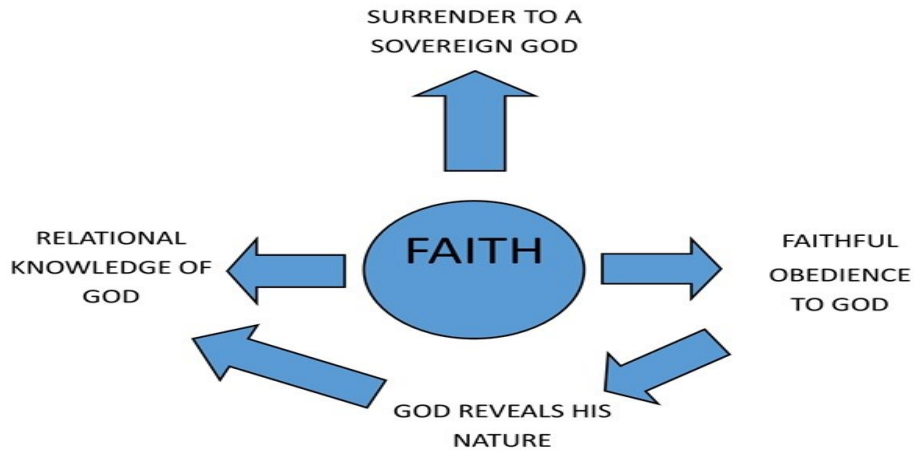
